

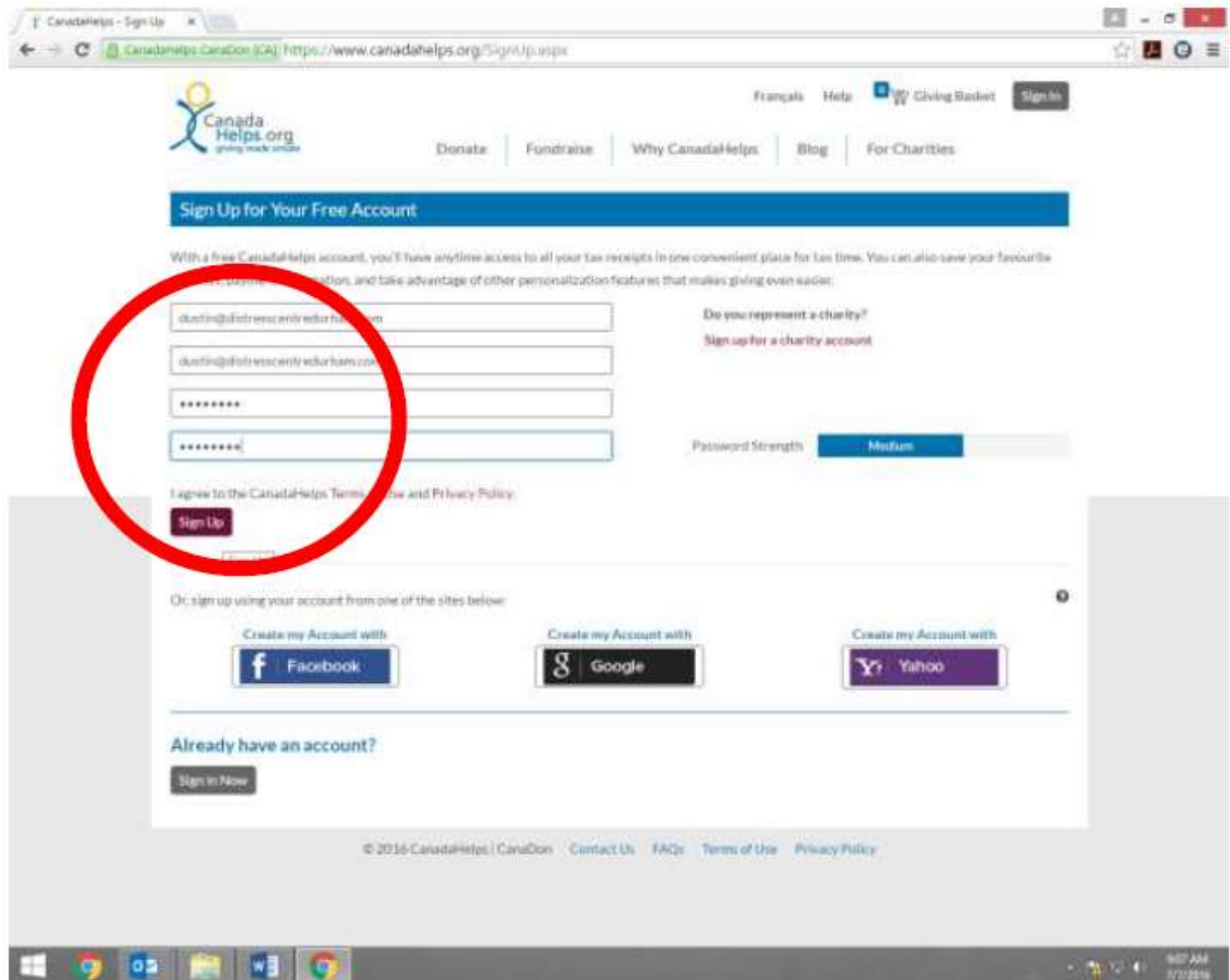
3. If you have an account from previous years, login on the left using your email address and password. If you forgot your password you can use the purple “Forgot Your Password” beside the sign-in link to reset it

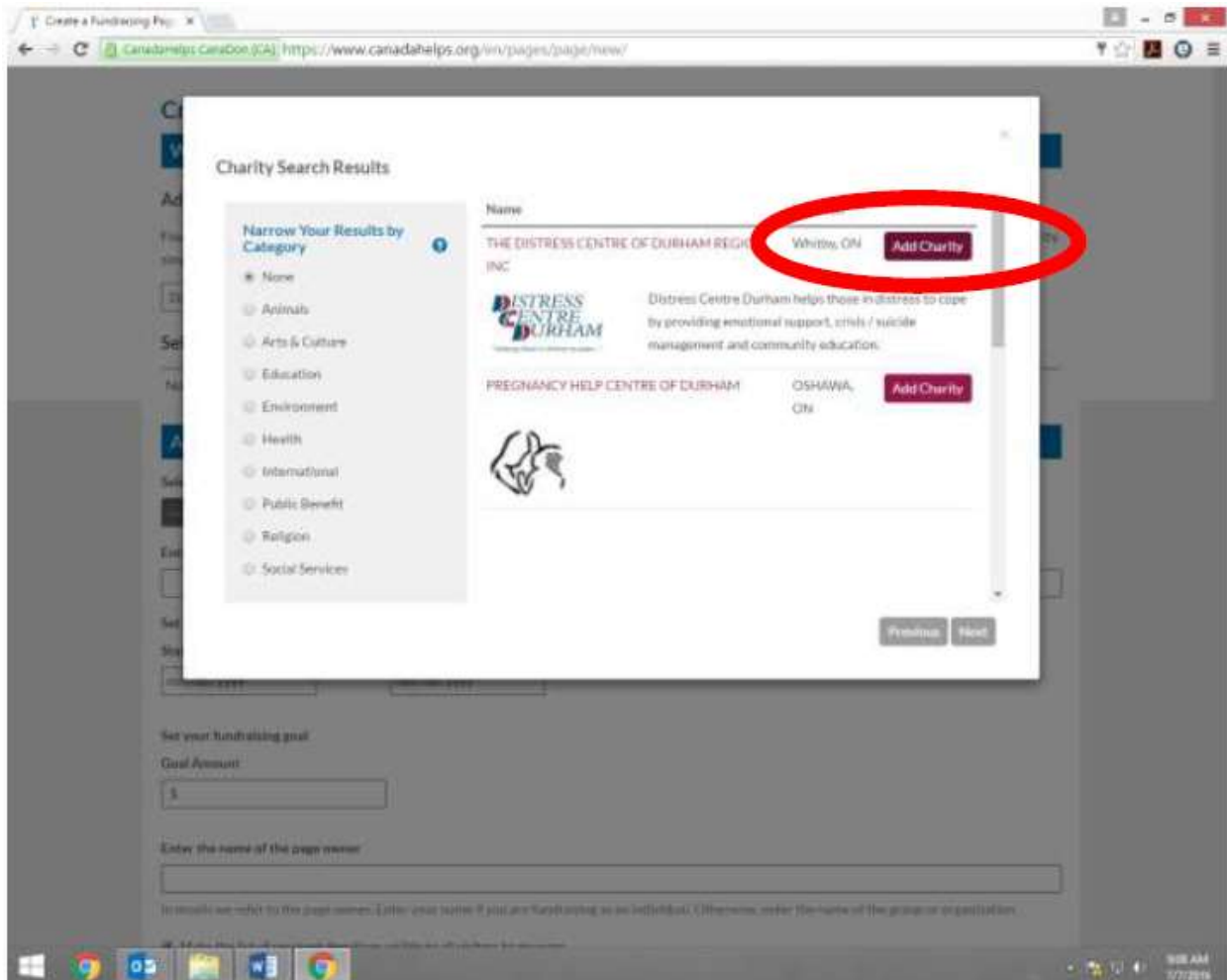
